Woodrow Mott, 94 of Elizabethtown, IL passed peacefully at 3:00 am, Friday, March 2, 2018 at Hardin County Hospital, Rosiclare, IL. He was born on April 10, 1923 in Elizabethtown to the late Wiley and Nellie Banks Mott.
